

《Narashino Language School International Student Application Guidelines》

○ **Period of stay for status of residence "Student "**

Regardless of the time of enrollment, the maximum period of stay for a student visa is 1 year and 3 months. While you are enrolled in a Japanese school, you will need to renew your student visa.

○ **How to apply**

- 1) On behalf of the international student, the Narashino Institute of foreign Languages will apply to the Tokyo Immigration Bureau for student.
 - 2) Please submit the necessary materials to the Narashino Institute of foreign Languages . Please pay the "Admission Application Fee (30,000 yen, tax included)" at the same time as submitting the materials.
 - 3) Submit the application materials to the Tokyo Regional Immigration Bureau. (It will take about 3 months to know the result of the application.)
 - 4) When you receive a certificate of residence status from Narashino language school, please pay the tuition fee and dormitory fee for one year (1,160,000 yen, tax included) in a lump sum. It is not possible to deliver in installments.
 - 5) After confirming the payment at our school, we will send you a "Certificate of Eligibility".
 - 6) Apply for a student visa at a Japan embassy or consulate in your country.
- * To apply for a visa, you will need a certificate of eligibility and other attached documents such as a passport.

○ **Academic Course (Enrollment period: April, July, October)**

This course is designed for students to go on to universities, junior colleges, vocational schools, etc.

Students will study Japanese comprehensively including conversation, reading comprehension, listening comprehension, and speech.

The study period is 2 years (April admission), 1 year and 9 months (July admission), and 1 year and 6 months (October admission).

○ **General Course (Enrollment period: April) * Currently under preparation**

This course is designed to help you acquire the Japanese skills to work in Japan. We will also prepare for the Specified Skilled Worker Evaluation Test.

The study period is one year (April enrollment).

○ **"Learning incentive fee" provided by the Japan government**

The Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology (MEXT) provides scholarships (30,000 yen per month and 360,000 yen per year) to students who excel in both grades and attendance.

○ **Narashi Open Air Language Institute's unique "scholarship"**

"Scholarship": A scholarship will be awarded at graduation to students who have been recognized for their significant improvement in grades while enrolled in Narashi Open Air Language Institute.

*For evaluation, the results of the Japanese Proficiency Test will be used. However, it is limited to those who have been recognized as having improved by two levels from the level at the time of admission to the academy.
